All players must abide by USSSA Rules, League Rules and team expectations. Players are expected conduct themselves appropriately ON and OFF the field. Good character must be exemplified at all times. Demonstrate respect for coaches, teammates, opponents, umpires, spectators, league staff and yourself.

Failure to comply with any rules or expectations may result in disciplinary action. This may include suspension from an inning, a game, suspension from two games, or removal from the team (board approval required).

If you are going to be absent or late, you must let coaches know ahead of time. Excusable absences for personal illness, personal or family emergencies, or academic reasons must be discussed with your coach or manager. Your teammates and coaches depend on your attendance, therefore, multiple unexcused absences may result in disciplinary action such as suspension from participation in play-offs or championship game or removal from the team.

All players are required to remain in the dugout during games. Players are NOT allowed to wander outside of the dugouts or sit in the stands. Restroom use will be allowed in pairs with coach's permission or with a parent. Maintain focus and attention during games and practice. This means refrain from talking to spectators and horse-play in the dugout. Be game ready at all times.
